

Third national supercomputer powers AI projects at NUHS

Instead of spending time writing referral letters for patients, doctors at the National University Health System (NUHS) will soon be able to tap on its version of ChatGPT.

Hospital staff will also be able to better allocate resources when they use artificial intelligence (AI) to estimate the duration of a patient's hospitalisation – much like how hotels have precise information on room occupancy rates.

Powering all these advancements is Singapore's third national supercomputer, called Prescience, located at National University Hospital. It has been operational since July 31.
